Stix's other love, he tells me, is fishing. This collection of tunes based on rivers, lakes and oceans where one might cast a line is as rich and varied as the waters of the world, and the treasures they hold.

The opening romp through the Duke Ellington/Peggy Lee song "I'm Gonna Go Fishin'" is a guaranteed smile-maker, as is the lovely bossa nova, "Little Boat." Tadd Dameron's classic, "Good Bait," gets a thorough work-out, and the interplay between Stix and pianist Taylor Eigsti is nothing short of brilliant.

Throughout this recording are prime examples of Stix's mastery of blues-tinged swing. It's basic, it's elemental, it's as natural as breathing...and just as we've been told, nothing happens without it. Seriously, NOTHING. This is a delightful project. Enjoy!

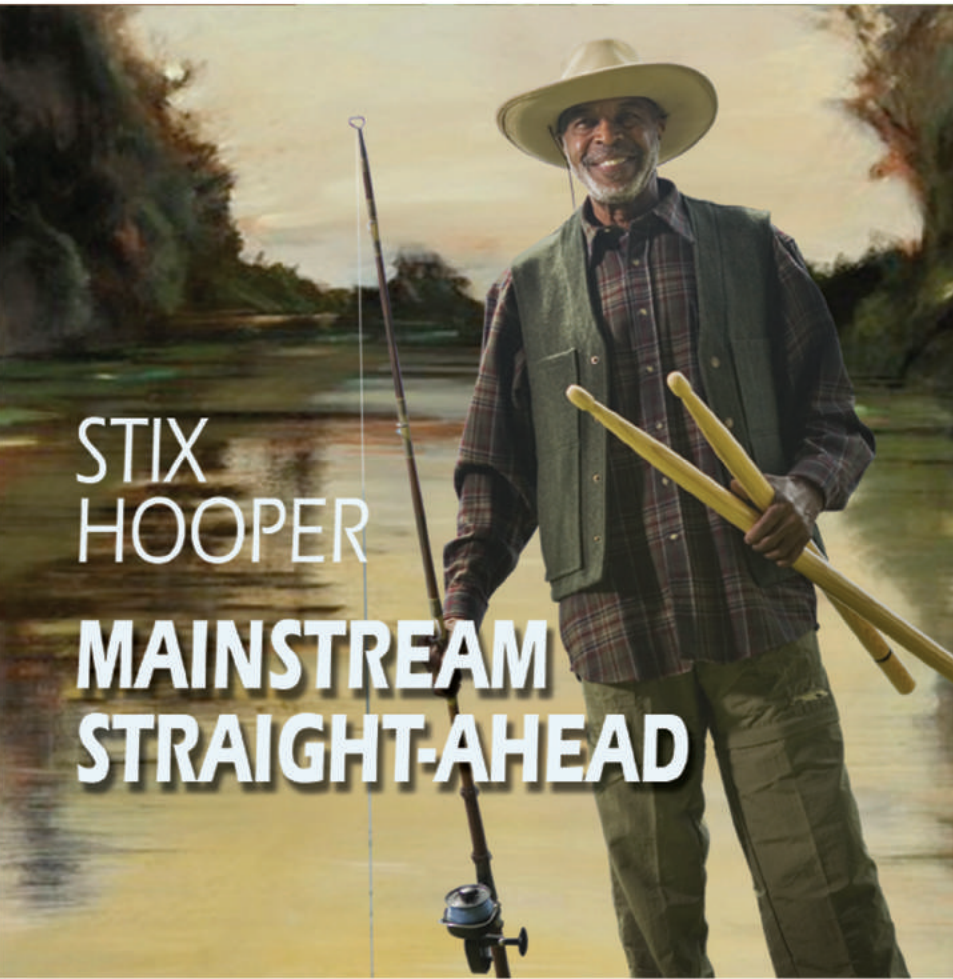
